



The Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) is a preventative program Designed to provide energy assistance to low-income households so that they can reach energy self-sufficiency.

Executive Directors Corner:

Now that the weather is changing and in an effort to provide the best service to you without interruption, we would like to provide you with a gentle reminder to please make sure that your driveway and walkways are free of snow or debris to allow our staff safe access to your homes. I would like to thank you in advance for complying with this request.

Due to the long and cold Michigan winters that we encounter, we are working on ways to insure that you are safe in the event of a winter weather emergency. We have devised a system that would be able to assist us to determine the level of need that you might have if we were to experience such an emergency.

With our service summaries, participants will receive two colored, one-half sheets of paper. One is green and the other is red. The green states "All is well". The red one states "Help is needed". Their purpose is to assist emergency personnel in determining if you require assistance during a weather related emergency. You would place the appropriate sheet in a front facing window to the street or driveway that can easily be seen from a distance.
