

EasyChickenPot Pie for Two

1/2 c. canned condensed reduced sodium cream of chicken 1/4 fat-free milk 1 c. mixed vegetables 1/2 c. cutup cooked chicken breast 1/2 c. Bisquick Heart Smart mix 1/4 c. fat-free milk 2 T. fat-free egg product or 1 egg white

Heat oven to 400degree. In ungreased 1-quart casserole, stir together soup and ¼ cup milk; stir in vegetables and chicken. Microwave uncovered on High for three minutes. In a small bowl, stir remaining ingredients until well blended. Pour over chick mixture. Bake uncovered about 20 minutes or until crust is golden brown.

1/2 c. Gold Medal all-purpose flour 1/4 tsp. baking soda 1/4 tsp. salt 1/4 c. M&M's


Gather ingredients and heat oven to 350 degrees. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper. In a Mix butter, peanut butter, and brown sugar with a spoon in a medium bowl until smooth. Add egg yolk and vanilla; stir vigorously for about 30 seconds or until creamy and mixture lightens in color. Shape dough into a ball: place on cookie sheet. Flatten slightly with the palm of your hand. Bake for 16-18 minutes or until golden brown. Cool 5 minutes; remove from cookie sheet to cooling rack to cool completely.
