#### Director's Corner

As the weather is getting cooler, cold and flu season is upon us. COVID-19 is still a concern as well. A reminder that if you are not feeling well, please call the office to reschedule any inhome services you may have. You can still receive Home Delivered Meals if you are COVID positive, just please let us know so that our staff can take precautionary measures. If you are at congregate diner, please ask that your meals are home delivered while you are ill.

CDC recommends that everyone who is eligible get a booster and stay up to date on their COVID-19 vaccines, especially people with weakened immune systems. Order free self-tests at COVIDtests.gov. Free tests are also available through local health departments.

If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19, you may have been infected with the virus. Follow CDC's recommendations for what to do if you were exposed. This includes wearing a high-quality mask when indoors around others (including inside your home) for 10 days, testing, and monitoring yourself for symptoms.



For safety, this will be a drive up distribution. Please remain in your vehicle. May pick up for more than one family. No Income requirements. May begin earlier to lessen traffic.

### Turkey Hash with Rice

2 cups diced turkey meat

1 cup raw rice

1 tablespoon fat

1 chopped green pepper

1 minced onion

1 small tart apple, chopped Salt and pepper


1/2 cup strained tomato juice

2 cups soup-stock

2 egg yolks 2 tablespoons grated cheese

Heat the fat, and brown the chopped pepper, and minced onion in it. Add the chopped apple, the rice, soup-stock, tomato juice and seasoning. Stir in the diced turkey meat and turn all into a casserole.

Bake in the covered casserole for three-quarters hour in a hot oven. Cover the top of the hash with beaten egg yolks and grated cheese; reheat until the cheese melts and serve with hot gravy.
