The safety of our staff is very important to us, and unfortunately that sometimes means canceling services due to road conditions. We plan ahead for closures with emergency frozen meals and shelf stable meals as well. We currently have the following: Flour, almonds, walnuts, dates, trail mix, shelf stable chicken, shelf stable beef stew and frozen peaches. You may pick up items in person on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 10 am-4 pm.

Kelly's Kitchen Corner – March 2023

Cheesy Chicken Casserole – 4- 1¹/₂ cup Servings



1 T. oil 1 c. diced onion 1 clove minced garlic 2 c. cooked chicken cut-up 1 ½ c. chicken broth ¾ c. cheddar cheese, shredded

1 c. instant rice uncooked

2 c. frozen vegetables (your choice)

Heat oil in a skillet over medium heat. Add onion and garlic. Cook for 2 minutes. Add chicken broth. Heat to boiling. Stir in rice and frozen vegetables. Reduce to low heat. Cover and cook for 10 minutes. Add chicken and cheese. Stir constantly until chicken is heated through and cheese is melted.

Curried Chicken and Peach Salad – 4 Servings

¹/₂ c fat-free mayonnaise 1 tsp. curry powder 2 c. cubed chicken, cooked ½ c. walnuts

¹/₄ c. raisins 2 medium peaches, sliced 1- 5oz. spring mix salad greens

Mix mayonnaise and curry powder; toss gently with chicken, walnuts, and raisins. Serve the chicken and peaches over greens.
